

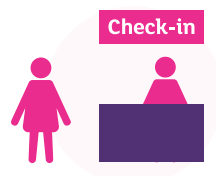
# An important message from BreastScreen NSW.



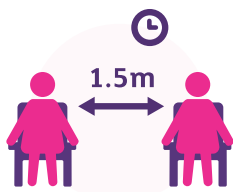
BreastScreen NSW has resumed breast screening. Your safety is our priority.

Ongoing cleaning of equipment and commonly used surfaces

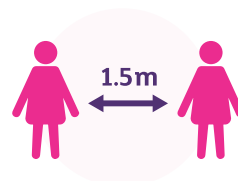


Precautionary questions around health and travel

It is important to note that a mammogram is a medical procedure that requires close contact with a radiographer. Radiographers use NSW Standard Health Precautions and will position women with minimal face-to-face contact.
