If you contract COVID-19 this holiday season and your regular doctor isn't available, help is still available.

After hours services and advice hotlines

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Considering COVID-19 antiviral medications

If you test positive for COVID-19, you may be eligible for antiviral treatments if you are:

- 70 years of age or older, regardless of risk factors and with or without symptoms
- 50 years of age or older with 2 additional risk factors
- First Nations person, 30 years of age or older and with 1 additional risk factor
- 18 years of age or older and moderately to severely immunocompromised.

If you can't contact your doctor, visit the healthdirect website Service Finder: healthdirect.gov.au/australian-health-services or call healthdirect on 1800 022 222 (free and available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week).

If you are eligible, ensure you give consent for your GP to prescribe oral medication in advance.
