

POLAR Walkthrough

Patients with abnormal ALT > 2 years who are at risk of Hep C

Patient Cohort:

- RACGP Active (step 2)
- Patients with abnormal ALT > 2 years (step 4)
- High Flag Count: patients with more Hep C risk elements in their record (step 4)

Note: Patient cohort can be modified by adding or removing steps according to the needs of your practice.

1. Log in to POLAR > Click Reports > Click Hepatitis



2. Click **RACGP Active Patients** (Filter patients who have visited your practice at least three times in the last two years)

3. Select Hepatitis C



4. Go to Screening > Click on the magnifying glass on the Abnormal ALT column > and type # in the search box > then press enter > Apply
