

POLAR Walkthrough

Cancer Screening – Non-urgent First Nations People due for breast screening

Patient cohort:

- Practice Active & RACGP Active (Filter pre-applied, option to remove by following step 2)
- Non-urgent patients due for breast cancer screening (step 5)
- First Nations patients (step 6)

Note: Patient cohort can be modified by adding or removing steps according to the needs of your practice.

1. Log into POLAR > Click Reports > Click QIPC Clinic Report








Optional: Unclick RACGP Active (Filters patients who have visited your practice at least three
times in the last two years, and whose record is Active in your practice clinical software) to
remove the filter and include all patients in your practice clinical software who attend
infrequently

3. Click Clinical > Select Cancer Screening




4. Select Breast Screening






5. Click non-urgent patients now due for screening




Note: Hover over the 'i' icon to find out what is considered a non-urgent patient due for screening.
