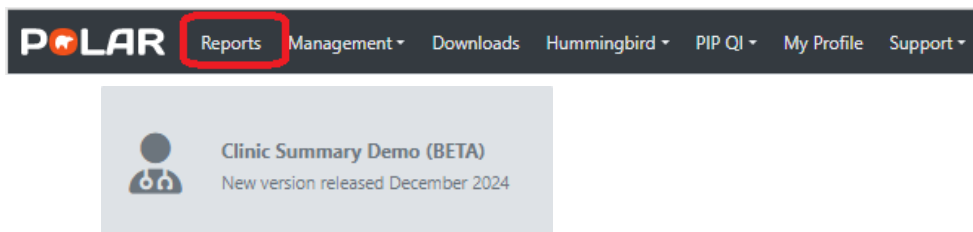
Patients with Hep C diagnosis but not on Direct Acting Antivirals (DAA) treatment

Patient Cohort:

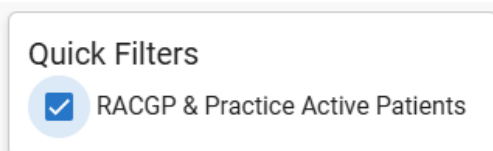
- Practice Active & RACGP Active (step 2)
- Has an active Hep C diagnosis (steps 4 and 5)
- Not on current Direct Acting Antivirals (DAA) treatment (step 6)

Note: Patient cohort can be modified by adding or removing steps according to the needs of your practice

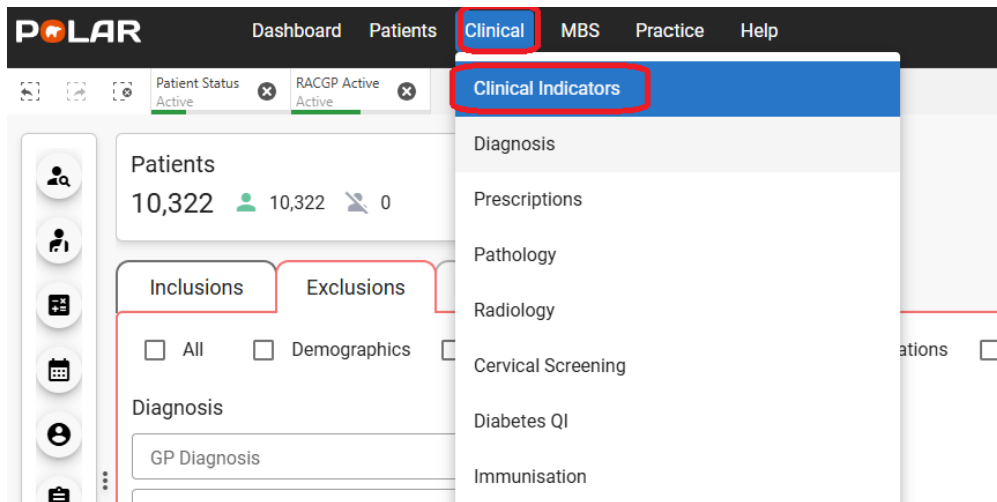
1. Log in to **POLAR** > Click **Reports** > Click **Clinic Summary Report**



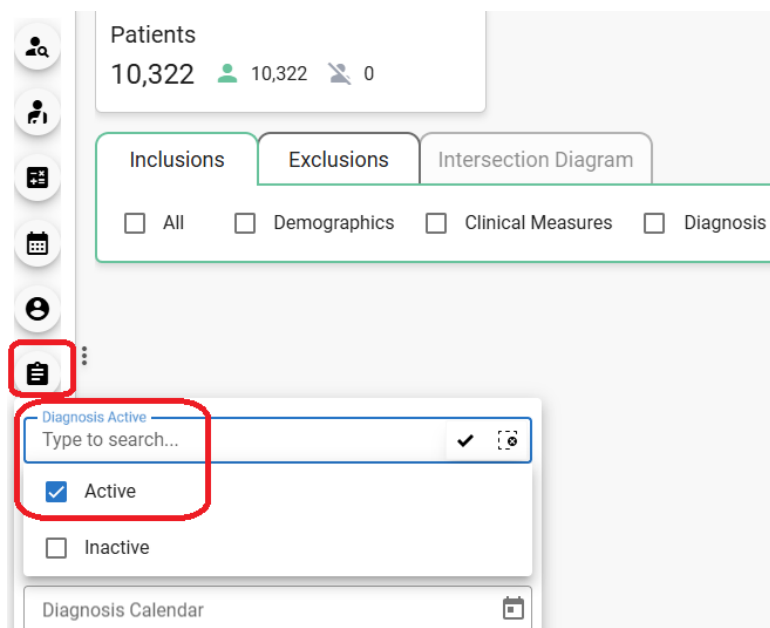
2. Click **RACGP & Practice Active Patients** (Filters patients who have visited your practice at least three times in the last two years, and their record is Active in your practice clinical software)




3. On the top menu bar > go to **Clinical** > choose **Clinical indicators**



4. Click on **Diagnosis** from side bar > on the **Diagnosis Active** select **Active**



5. Click on **Inclusions Filters** > Select **Diagnosis** > On **SNOMED** type **Hepatitis C** > Select **Viral Hepatitis C** > Apply ✓
