How does my GP use my information?

Your general practice securely records information about your health.

Your GP may use this information about your health to take part in quality improvement and research to improve the quality and care provided to you and your family.

What happens to my information?

Be assured, the information collected, used and stored for these purposes remains anonymous to comply with the Australian Privacy Principles contained in the Commonwealth Privacy Act 1998.

In the unlikely event of a breach of your data, your GP is obligated to notify you as soon as practicable.
