You may have already claimed some sessions before your management plan appointment at this practice. Please check with your provider(s) as this might be included in your 5 sessions

Important notes:

- You can claim a total of five visits each calendar year (1 January to 31 December) through your management plan. You are welcome to attend more sessions with your allied health provider, however, anything above 5 visits won't be eligible for a Medicare rebate
- You can split the 5 visits across different allied health providers, but they must be providing services that support the management of your chronic condition
- You can log on to your MyGov account to see how many sessions you have left
- Each allied health provider has their own fee structure – some may bulk bill, while others may charge a gap fee. Please check this with your provider before your appointment.

Your referral to your allied health provider (such as a physiotherapist or podiatrist) might look generic, that's okay. It's not clinic specific, so you can choose or change your provider within the same field. If you need another copy, please ask reception.
